

Veterans or their survivors aren't typically notified by the VA if they are eligible for benefits.

Check with all 3 VA branches for benefits:

- 1. Veterans Health Administration
- 2. Veterans Benefits Administration
- 3. National Cemetery Administration





Aging veterans receiving
Disability Compensation payments
may eventually need more help
and can apply for additional
"Aid and Attendance" amount.

Wartime veterans with:

- 1. No service-connected disability
- 2. No combat duty
- 3. No overseas service

are eligible for a Pension plus an additional "Aid and Attendance" amount.





Veterans' widows (surviving spouses) are eligible to receive the Aid and Attendance benefit.

Before filing a VBA claim, consider filing a short "Intent to File" form which can set an earlier effective date for you benefits.





Never file a VA claim for Aid and Attendance on your own unless you have that expertise. Free help is available from VetAssist and others.
