

The VA's "Aid and Attendance" benefit is for wartime veterans, or their surviving spouses, who meet certain medical and financial requirements

VA Requirements - 3M's

1. Military Service: Minimum 90 days active duty, with at least one day during wartime, and an honorable discharge.

Gulf war veterans must have served active duty for 2 years, or the full period for which they were called for active duty.

2. Medical Condition: Non service-connected disability which requires assistance with activities of daily living.

3. Money Limitation: A net worth (income & assets) at or less than \$138,489 (as of 12. 1. 2021).

A primary residence and auto are not counted as part of net worth. Ongoing, unreimbursed medical and long-term care expenses may reduce income.
